ENROLLMENT RESERVATION FEE

Enrollment for the 2021-2022 school year will begin on Monday, May 17, 2021. *The non-refundable, discounted early enrollment reservation fee is \$125 per student for all students in kindergarten through twelfth grade.* Families may submit re-enrollment paperwork and the re-enrollment fee only when this year's tuition balance is current.

Beginning June 1, 2021, the enrollment reservation fee will be \$175. No enrollment will be considered complete until the enrollment reservation fee is paid.

BOOK FEE

All kindergarten students will be required to pay a non-refundable book fee of \$175. All students in first through sixth grades will be required to pay a non-refundable book fee of \$210. This book fee is due in full with the first tuition payment on August 1, 2021. For enrollments after August 1, this fee is due with the enrollment fee.

All students in grades seven through twelve will be expected to buy their own books. Book lists with textbook titles and ISBN numbers will be published and made available on the school's website in the summer. Students may purchase new, used or electronic textbooks (when available).

SECONDARY ACTIVITY FEES

All students in grades seven through twelve will be required to pay a non-refundable activity fee of \$250. This fee helps cover the costs of extra- and co-curricular activities such as athletic events and fine arts concerts. This activity fee will be added in with tuition and may be paid in installments with tuition payments. Students who withdraw from school before the end of the year will be expected to pay the balance of this fee upon withdrawal.

Home school students who wish to participate in extra-curricular activities offered by Lake Orion Baptist School must pay a fee for each activity in which they participate. The music activity fee for home-school students will be \$100 per year; this will make the student eligible to participate in all school music groups. The sports activity fee for home-school students will be \$100 per sport. The fee must be paid before the student begins participating in the activity.

PAYMENT PLAN

A ten-month payment plan is available for the 2021-2022 school year. The plan begins in August and is complete in May, with one-tenth of the total bill due each month. Tuition payments are due on the 1st of each month; a \$15 late fee will be applied each month to any account that is delinquent.

RETURNED CHECKS

Checks returned for "Non-sufficient Funds" will carry a \$25 charge. If the due date has passed, the payment will also be considered late and subject to a late fee. Lake Orion Baptist School will not accept post-dated checks.

TUITION SCHEDULE – Non-FBCLO Church Member

Please Note: Families who are active members of First Baptist Church of Lake Orion qualify for a significant tuition discount. The application form for this discount may be picked up in either the church office or the school office. The discount must be applied for each year.

**Kindergarten will be tuition-free for the 2021-22 school year for families with at least one other full-time student enrolled in the school.*

**Kindergarten families with only a kindergartner at LOBS who reenroll their child in 1st grade at LOBS for the 2022-2023 school year will receive a \$2,910 tuition credit at that time.*

**Kindergarten families are responsible for reservation and book fees.*

There is no additional tuition charged for the fifth student (and all students beyond the fourth) in a family. In an effort to help families, children receiving tuition-free kindergarten will be included in the calculation of multi-student discounts.
